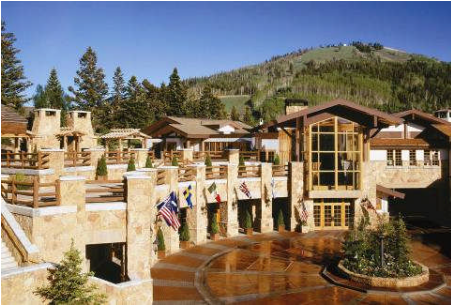


# Meeting Information
